## BEGINNING DRAWING

Monday 7 PM - 9 PM

(arrive early to begin promptly at 7 PM)

*Classes are limited to six students.*

September 25 - introduction to the art of seeing and drawing tools

October 2 - measurement and proportion; line

October 9 - 1 and 2 point perspective; line

October 16 - value with pencil; tone

October 23 - value with charcoal; tone

October 30 - page use and composition

November 6 - putting it all together

November 13 - putting it all together

**Description:** This is an introductory class that covers the basic practice of drawing. Anyone can learn to draw given the desire! The introductory class will work from life study and students will experiment with black and white dry media including pencil and charcoal. The class will cover measurement, proportion, perspective, line, and value (tone). Several in-class lessons will be completed along with a finished still-life drawing. Outside work will be encouraged. *A supply list will be provided and supplies will be available at AOE Artworld. Estimated cost of supplies is 30.00. (some supplies will be provided) 13 yrs. - adult welcome.*

## BEGINNING PAINTING - OIL OR ACRYLIC

Tuesday 7 PM - 10 PM

(arrive early to begin promptly at 7 PM)

*Classes are limited to six students.*

September 26 - introduction to materials and paint mixing

October 3 - choosing a composition and color palette; preliminary drawing/composition

October 10 - under-painting (getting started)

October 17 - over-painting and brush techniques

October 24 - continued

October 31 - continued

November 7 - continued; group discussion/crit

November 14 - completion of painting

**Description:** This is an introductory class that covers the basic practice of painting from life. Anyone can learn to paint given the desire! The class will cover paint mixing, brush techniques and composition. In-class lessons will be completed along with a finished 18 x 24 canvas painting. Outside work will be encouraged. *A supply list will be provided and supplies will be available at AOE Artworld. Estimated cost of supplies is 50.00 - 75.00 (acrylic tends to be less costly). 13 yrs. - adult welcome.*

## INDEPENDENT STUDY

Wednesday 7 PM - 10 PM

(arrive early to begin promptly at 7 PM)

September 27, October 4, 11, 18, 25, November 1, 8 and 15

*Classes are limited to six students.*

**Description:** This is an open studio class for students who have had some background experience in drawing and painting. Students will work independently with their own choice of subject, size and materials—suggestions for projects will be given upon request. Discussion, demonstrations and individualized advise will be given during each studio session and group discussions will prove to be a valuable tool in the learning process. Outside work will be encouraged. *Estimated cost of supplies is variable pending individual study. Adults welcome.*
